



# IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ELEMENTARY ENROLLMENT

## 3 -4 YEARS OF AGE:

DPT	4 Doses
POLIO	3 Doses
Measles	1 Dose (given after the 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday) and may be listed as MMR
Mumps/Rubella	1 Dose (given after the 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday) and may be listed as MMR
Hib	3 or 4 Doses (with at least one given on/after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday) <b>OR</b> 1 Dose (given on/after 15 months of age)
Hep B	3 doses, <u>or</u> serologic confirmation of immunity
Varicella	1 Dose (given after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday), <u>or</u> written validation from parent or doctor of approximate date of disease, <u>or</u> serologic confirmation of immunity.
TB Test	Not required (record date & result if available)
Hepatitis A	2 doses at least 6 months apart
Pneumococcal	1 dose after 24 months of age, <u>unless</u> series completed before 24 months (Completed Pneumococcal [Prevnar, PCV7] series includes: 2-3 doses before 12 months of age, and an additional 1 dose after 12 months; <u>or</u> 0-1 dose before 12 months, and an additional 2 doses after 12 months)
Influenza	Not required after 5 years of age Not required but <i>highly recommended annually</i>

## KINDERGARTEN:

DPT	At least 4 doses (with at least one dose after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday)
POLIO	3 or 4 Doses (with one after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday)
Measles	2 Doses (given after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday) and may be listed as MMR
<b>Mumps/Rubella</b>	<b>2 Doses (given after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday) and may be listed as MMR</b>
Hib	Not required after 5 years of age (record dates if available)
Hep B	3 doses, <u>or</u> serologic confirmation of immunity
<b>Varicella</b>	<b>2 Doses (given after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday), <u>or</u> written validation from parent or doctor of approximate date of disease, <u>or</u> serologic confirmation of immunity.</b>
TB Test	Not required (record date & result if available)
<b>Hepatitis A</b>	<b>2 Doses at least 6 months apart</b>
Pneumococcal	Not required after 5 years of age (record date if available)
Influenza	Not required but <i>highly recommended annually</i>

## 1<sup>st</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> GRADE

DPT	At least 4 doses <u>before 7</u> years of age; at least 3 doses <u>after 7</u> years of age (all must have one dose after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday); A booster is required every 10 years (Tdap/Td)
POLIO	3 or 4 Doses (with one after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday)
Measles	2 Doses (given after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday) and may be listed as MMR
Mumps/Rubella	1 Dose (given after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday) and may be listed as MMR; <i>second dose highly recommended</i>
Hib	Not required after 5 years of age (record dates if available)
Hep B	3 doses, <u>or</u> serologic confirmation of immunity
Varicella	1 Dose (given after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday), <u>or</u> written validation from parent or doctor of approximate date of disease, <u>or</u> serologic confirmation of immunity. If first dose given on/after 13 <sup>th</sup> birthday- 2 doses are required. <i>Second dose highly recommended for all children 4-18 yrs old who have not had the disease.</i>
TB Test	Not required (record date & result if available)
Hepatitis A	Not required, but <i>highly recommended</i> (record dates if available)
Pneumococcal	Not required after 5 years of age (record date if available)
Influenza	Not required but <i>highly recommended annually</i>
Meningococcal	Not required but <i>highly recommended for children ages 11-18 yrs.</i>



## IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR SECONDARY ENROLLMENT

### 7<sup>TH</sup> GRADE:

DPT	At least 3 doses (with at least one dose after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday); <b>A booster (Tdap) is required if 5 or more years have passed since the last dose of tetanus containing vaccine. If five years has not elapsed since the last dose of tetanus containing vaccine, then it will become due as soon as the 5 year interval passes.</b>
Polio	3 or 4 Doses (with one after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday)
Measles	2 Doses (given after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday) and may be listed as MMR
Mumps/Rubella	1 Dose (given after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday) and may be listed as MMR; <i>second dose highly recommended</i>
Hib	Not required after 5 years of age (record dates if available)
Hep B	3 doses, <u>or</u> serologic confirmation of immunity
Varicella	<b>2 Doses (given after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday), <u>or</u> written validation from parent or doctor of approximate date of disease, <u>or</u> serologic confirmation of immunity.</b>
TB Test	Not required (record date & result if available)
Hepatitis A	Not required, but <i>highly recommended</i> (record dates if available)
Pneumococcal	Not required after 5 years of age (record date if available)
Influenza	Not required but <i>highly recommended annually</i>
Meningococcal	<b>1 Dose</b>

### 8<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> GRADE:

DPT	At least 3 doses (with at least one dose after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday); A booster is required every 10 years (Tdap)
Polio	3 or 4 Doses (with one after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday); Not required for age 18 and older
Measles	2 Doses (given after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday) and may be listed as MMR
Mumps/Rubella	1 Dose (given after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday) and may be listed as MMR; <i>second dose highly recommended</i>
Hib	Not required after 5 years of age (record dates if available)
Hep B	3 doses, <u>or</u> serologic confirmation of immunity
Varicella	1 Dose (given after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday), <u>or</u> written validation from parent or doctor of approximate date of disease, <u>or</u> serologic confirmation of immunity. *If first dose given on/after 13 <sup>th</sup> birthday- 2 doses are required. <i>Second dose highly recommended for all children 4-18 yrs old who have not had the disease.</i>
TB Test	Not required (record date & result if available)
Hepatitis A	Not required, but <i>highly recommended</i> (record dates if available)
Pneumococcal	Not required after 5 years of age (record date if available)
Influenza	Not required but <i>highly recommended annually</i>
Meningococcal	Not required but <i>highly recommended for children ages 11-18 yrs.</i>
