

2011 PROPOSED BOND Major Scope Summary Descriptions

Curriculum & Instruction: to engage elementary and secondary students and impact classroom instruction in various subjects/programs.

Technology: to purchase up to 16,000 devices for students and staff over the five year period -- approximately 4,000 laptops for teachers and staff and up to 12,000 devices for students and implement wireless network and IP phone system across district.

Security Systems: to add new digital cameras and recording equipment.

Building Renovations: *See attached sheet.*

ADA Compliance: to improve program access and compliance with American Disabilities Act.

Electrical Equipment: to upgrade switchgear and panels for electrical wiring.

EMS: to implement new Energy Management System, a computerized system which controls AC/Heating.

Flooring: to repair and/or replace flooring.

AC/HVAC: to repair and/or replace air conditioning and heating units.

Playgrounds: to install safety upgrades and/or replace dated equipment.

Roofs: to repair and/or replace roofs.

Plumbing Systems: to repair and/or replace water and sewer lines.

Pavement: to repair drives and parking lots.

Fire Alarms: to upgrade fire alarm systems.

Natatoriums: to replace filtration systems, resurface pools and renovate lockers, office and shower areas.

Auditoriums: to renovate seating, flooring, ceilings and sound/lighting.

Note: Funding for the proposed RISD 2011 bond program, if approved, will come from the sale of general obligation bonds. These bonds, in school districts, are intended to furnish and equip school buildings and programs. The proposed items in the program draft reflect the items that RISD expects to address in the 2011 bond program. However, under the governing rules, the proposed budget amount assigned to anticipated projects is an estimate and may vary or be redistributed based upon need.

2011 PROPOSED BOND Building Renovations at 1970s Campuses

Junior High Schools

Apollo JH: to repair foundation issues, replace hallway floors, student lockers and wall finishes as needed.

Forest Meadow JH: to renovate existing space in lecture hall and portion of library and create additional classroom space and student restrooms.

Liberty JH: to renovate existing space to create a first floor bookroom and conference room and to renovate fine arts wing to create practice space.

Parkhill JH: to renovate existing space in lecture hall to create additional classroom space and to renovate fine arts areas.

Elementary Schools

Big Springs: to renovate the office area and replace hallway trim.

Brentfield Intermediate: to renovate the office area and open concept instructional areas of lower grade levels and to repair site water drainage issues.

Brentfield Primary: to repair site water drainage issues.

Dartmouth: to renovate clinic, corridors and office area.

Jess Harben: to renovate clinic and office area and to replace floor/ceilings in gym, cafeteria and corridors.

Merriman Park: to renovate clinic, corridors, office area and open concept instructional areas.

Moss Haven: to renovate clinic, corridors and office area.

Richland: to renovate clinic, corridors and office area.

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
