## COST

- \$200 per session
- \$100 per session – students who qualify for free or reduced lunch. Scholarship applications, available in the counseling office, are due Feb. 17.
- \$450 per session – out-of-district students
- Full tuition must be paid at the time of registration.
- Cash, credit and debit cards, cashier's checks and money orders will be accepted at in-person registration. *NO personal checks will be accepted.*
- Only credit and debit cards will be accepted online.
- A convenience fee will be charged for all credit or debit card transactions.
