STEP 1: CHECK TO SEE IF YOU ARE REGISTERED

Click [here](#) to visit the Secretary of State's website to see if you are registered to vote at your current address.

STEP 2: MAIL OR DROP OFF VOTER REGISTRATION FORM

If you're not registered:

- Fill in the voter application form from [here](#) or pick up a voter registration card at most public libraries, post offices and public high schools.
- Drop off or mail your completed registration form to [your county's Voter Registrar's Office](#) with a postmark no later than Monday, Feb. 5th.

STEP 3: CHECK THE MAIL FOR YOUR REGISTRATION CARD

In Texas, once you are registered, you won't have to re-register for future state and local elections unless your home residence changes.

So take the time to do what matters for year's to come.
