## *Students*

All campuses will receive a brief student reminder video about **how and when to report bullying**.

Campuses will review the **Standard Response Protocol**, which provides a continuity of expectations and actions throughout a student's educational career.

Students will complete all safety drills during **Safety Week**, Aug. 29 to Sep. 2.

## *Staff*

All staff will participate in **Standard Response Protocol training**. "I Know What To Do" days are scheduled throughout the school year to build confidence and knowledge of keeping everyone safe in the event of an emergency.

## *Community*

Parents of RISD students will receive letter that details the importance of **district safety protocols and the "See Something Say Something" mindset** all stakeholders should have as schools return to full capacity. The common vocabulary of SRP allows first responders to understand what type of emergency a campus is experiencing and how to respond appropriately. These will be shared during the Parents Safety Committee meeting on Aug. 11.
